 - CMMU 194 Analysis of Field Materials
 - CMMU 195 Senior Thesis/Project (optional)
- Three upper-division topical courses, from approved list

- CMMU 10 and 1-topical are required to declare the major.
- Before going on field study, students must complete three upper-division topical courses in their health or economic justice field study focus.
